## Tell Me About Yourself

Parlez-moi de vous. (Tell me about yourself) NOTE

Passé composé is used to refer to an event or action that was started earlier (in the past) and is completed or ongoing in the present.



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# **Academic or Personal Projects**

Parlez-moi des projets académiques ou personels importants que vous avez réalisés. (Tell me about any stand out academic or personal projects you have completed)

- "I worked on a team project where we had to build a small bridge that's capable of sustaining a 200 kg mass. We accomplished this by creating composite fibers that we then arranged into a spider web structure. We beat all the other teams with our project! This experience has prepared me to do conceptualization, evaluation and design of large scale industrial structures."
  - « J'ai participé à un projet d'équipe où nous devions construire un pont miniature capable de soutenir un poids d'au moins 200 kg. Nous avons accompli cela en créant des fibres composites et en les assemblant en une structure semblable à une toile d'araignée. Grâce à notre projet, nous avons battu toutes les autres équipes! Cette expérience m'a préparé à faire la conceptualisation, l'évaluation et le design de structures industrielles de grande envergure. »

# How to Answer When You Don't Have Experience

Vous impliquez-vous dans des activités parascolaires? (Are you involved in any extracurricular activities?)

- "I auditioned for the University Choir last week. This will help me overcome my shyness of performing in front of a crowd, which is an essential quality to be a good leader."
  - « J'ai passé une audition la semaine dernière pour joindre la chorale de l'université. C'est une activité qui m'aidera à surmonter ma timidité lorsque je dois me produire devant un public; être un bon orateur est une qualité essentielle pour être un bon leader. »

If you are not involved in the activities you are specifically asked about, bring up other events, groups, activities, or causes you are involved with, or the efforts you are making right now to join a group or organization.




